WATERCOLOR BUNNY DISH



MATERIALS

DB37209 Bunny Dish
Detail Brush
Medium Brush
Liner Brush
Water Based Marker

COLORS

CMM 31- Licorice
CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 16 - Chiffon
CMM 101 - Fresh Heather
CMM 93 - London Fog
CMM 19 - Banana Boat
CMM 5 - Coral Reef
CMM 48 - Guacamole
CMM 44 - Battleship

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use a marker to sketch out the lines on the bunny so you know where to place the ears, face, tail, and front leg. No need to sketch out flowers.
2. Add water to Chiffon, 50% water to 50% paint. Paint the pink section of the ear with 2 coats.
3. Add water to London Fog, 50% water to 50% paint. Paint in the rest of the front ear, the bottom of the face, the front of the leg, and around the body.
4. Add water to Battleship, 50% water to 50% paint. Paint in the back ear, the top of the head, the space between the leg and body, the edge of the back, and around the tail to create a shadow.
5. Fill in the eye with 2 coats of Licorice.
6. Use a detail brush to fill in the nose.
7. Make the flowers with a medium brush and Banana Boat, Coral Reef, and Fresh Heather.
8. Finally add the stems, leaves, and grass with 2 coats of Guacamole.

TIPS

- Don't worry about 3 coats of paint, we are going for a watercolor effect.
- You can use a brush with just water in it to brush over any colors you want to dilute.
- The flowers are just quick 5 petal flowers with varied heights.
